Tsavo East National Park is a jewel among the world's wild spaces. Spanning 13,747 square kilometers of pristine wilderness, it is the most extensive protected area in Kenya. It is also host to greater biodiversity than any other park in the world, as it is here that the northern and southern forms of fauna meet. David Sheldrick was the founding Warden of Tsavo East from 1949 to 1976. Under his leadership, the park was transformed from an inhospitable land into what is today Kenya's largest and most famous National Park. Tsavo is home to the largest population of elephants in Kenya, and the southern area of the park is particularly renowned for the size of its herds. Across the open plains, find scores of buffalo, giraffe, eland, oryx, zebra, and more. This quiet corner is a place where big cats thrive, from the infamous Tsavo lions to stealthy leopards and speedy cheetahs. At the heart of it all is the picturesque Galana River, a lifeline for wildlife of all shapes and sizes. Galdessa Little sits on its banks, facing the landmark Yatta Plateau, which is the longest lava flow in the world. The camp offers a unique glimpse into this natural world: at any given moment, you might see hippos wallowing in the mud, elephants strolling down the shore, or crocodiles soaking up the sun's rays.

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Galdessa, the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust's newest property, is composed of two separate camps: Galdessa Camp and Galdessa Little. With its safari-style setting and front row view of all the wildlife activity on the Galana River, Galdessa Camp invites guests to immerse themselves in the untouched corners of Tsavo. Foster parent guests also have special access to the SWT's Voi Reintegration Unit with prior written permission from Nairobi office, where they can have a firsthand look at our work raising and rehabilitating orphaned elephants. Galdessa was originally built in the early 1980s, but it was later purchased by SWT. It was completely rebuilt in 2018, incorporating luxury touches while preserving the integrity of the property and the old-world charm it evokes. Galdessa Little and Galdessa Camp along with four other properties, makes up the SWT's not-for-profit portfolio of ecolodges. By staying at our eco-lodges, you are directly contributing to the preservation of the surrounding ecosystem: all revenue generated is put towards conservation initiatives within the Tsavo Conservation Area.

# **ACCOMMODATION:**

Each of Galdessa Little's three tented bedrooms feels like its own private oasis. Shaded by doum palms and offering stunning views of the Galana River, each tent is elevated and situated under thatch roofs. Take advantage of the breathtaking vistas from your bedroom's front deck or enjoy a shower under the stars. The rooms are a combination of twin and double beds, and each includes an en suite bathroom with indoor and outdoor showers.

Sitting under a thatched roof, the airy mess area provides a large, communal space for guests to gather and immerse themselves in Tsavo's natural beauty. The combined living and dining room gives way to wooden decks perched on the river's edge. The terraced swimming pool, which sits in the shade of doum palms, offers basking beaches and uninterrupted views of the Galana River and beyond.

Check in is strictly after 10am. Check out is strictly before 9:30am.

The well-appointed kitchen is equipped with two generous fridges, a freezer, gas cooker and oven, gas BBQ, and an ice cream machine.

#### **ACCESS:**

- By air: 60 minutes by air from Wilson Airport (Nairobi) to the Lugard Falls Airstrip, which is 8 kilometers from camp.
- By train: 4 hours via Kenya's brand new train service from Nairobi to Voi town, which is situated 4 kilometers from the Tsavo East National Park main entrance gate.
  - 1 hour from Mariakani (Coast) to Voi Town.
- By car: 5-6 hours driving by road from Nairobi to Tsavo East's Manyani Gate. 2 hours driving by road from Mombasa to Voi Gate. From Voi Gate a further 35km to Galdessa Camp.

### **SEASON:**

Galdessa Little is open all year.

#### **CLIMATE:**

Galdessa Little has an excellent climate with hot days and little humidity through the year. During the rainy seasons of November and April/May, expect refreshing rain showers. July/August are the coolest months, and fleeces may be needed in the mornings and evenings. February and March are the hottest months.

#### WHAT TO BRING:

Apart from your food and beverages — including drinking water — here are a few more ideas to help you pack:

- Sandals, flip-flops, hat, sunglasses, swimming costume.
- High-strength sunscreen, moisturizer, lip salve, mosquito repellent.
- A warm fleece or jumper for cooler evenings (particularly in July/August).
- Personal first aid kit.
- Torch with spare batteries, binoculars, camera equipment.
- iPod and portable speakers, playing cards, board games.

#### **POWER:**

The electricity in the property is powered by both solar and generator. The lighting in the camp is set at a muted level, which creates an optimal natural ambiance so guests can enjoy the star-studded nights. There are plug points available throughout the camp, making charging of equipment simple and straightforward. At night, muted flood lights positioned in trees illuminate the wildlife action taking place on the riverbanks.

# **WATER:**

While the water is fresh and clean from a filtered well, we recommend sealed bottled water for drinking purposes. The water is heated using solar, and in the hot months the water can be become extremely hot as a result.

#### **HEALTH PRECAUTIONS:**

Galdessa Little falls within a malarial area, but as it is so far from any significant human habitation, cases are it is very rare here. However, there is no doctor in the immediate vicinity, so necessary precautions should be exercised at all times. As with all destinations in Africa, clear medical advice is required from your doctor and comprehensive medical insurance is strongly advised. When travelling in Kenya, we recommend that guests take out the very affordable Flying Doctor Service membership: Flying Doctor enquiries + 254 (0) 733 639 088. At the lodge, there is a basic first aid medical box and a Defibrillator machine.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS:**

Galdessa Little has Wi-Fi available and intermittent mobile phone reception.

#### **CHILDREN:**

Due to wildlife roaming the area, children under the age of 5 are not encouraged. Please consult with the SWT should you have younger children. An adult should supervise children over 5 at all times.

Walkways are well lit, but please be sure that you walk with a torch at night at all times.
